New Updates (since last bulletin)

Headteacher conference

Thank you to everyone who was able to join us at the conference and thank you to Matt and Amanda for sharing their time and expertise in planning the conference and leading us.

I hope that everyone who went really got something from our time together that is helpful now and into the future.

We will be sharing slides and notes from the Conference and the next Heads' Forum will feature time to follow up on outcomes.

<u>Last call – Expressions of interest in Executive Director of School Improvement</u> <u>post</u>

Thanks to all colleagues who have provided me with feedback on the proposed role of Executive Director of School Improvement (attached again with this bulletin for reference). The feedback has been positive. Directors have now approved the role and have also approved that we seek to appoint from within the Trust in the first instance.

As explained previously, we are open to alternative ways of filling this post, including a temporary secondment, or by splitting the post including through a job-share arrangement. Directors have approved a salary scale for the full post, but the range will need to be confirmed depending on how the post is filled.



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At the point of sharing the role proposal, I asked for expressions of interest and there are colleagues who have got in touch with me to discuss their interest in the role. At this point, I am making a final call to any colleague who has an interest in the roll, but who has yet to speak to me, to get in touch by Friday 31st March.

I will then move forward with a process to arrive, hopefully, at appointment to the role.

Data lead capacity

I am keen to explore what capacity and interest there may be from data leads within schools to do some work across the Trust in the remainder of this academic year.

There is a relatively small amount of work needed to support the production of some Trust wide reports. There may also be an opportunity to represent the Trust in some work with Learn Sheffield during the summer term. All of this work would be helping to inform the long-term plan for data support across the Trust next year and beyond.

At this stage, I am keen just to speak to colleagues across the trust who have an interest and could have some capacity to support with some work. This will help me to plan the scope of what we can do. I recognise that capacity is stretched everywhere, so I do want to note that there would likely be considerable overlap between some of the work needed and what colleagues will be doing already within their individual schools.

If you have a colleague who may have interest and some capacity to help, please could you let me know before the end of term.

Local Academy Committee Spring Term Report to Trust Board
